Entry Restrictions

Individual: Unlimited entry per club

Pairs: Maximum 4 teams per club

4 person teams: Maximum 3 teams per club**

Each competitor is only permitted to enter one individual SERC event

Competition area is held in 50m pool with 4 lane width. Individual events have ½ the available pool area.

NB U/19 Individual competitors will compete in the Open Individual SERC event. The Open & U/19 events will be run as one event. At the completion of the event competitors results separated so places can be awarded for each event.

ENTRY

- Entry and Payments closes Monday, 14th March 5.00 pm

- No late entries or payments permitted.
- All reserves must be shown on each team entry. Each team entry is entitled to have 50% of the total team number shown as reserves - ie Summary Sheet and Entry Cards relay team entry – must contain names of the 4 team members plus the 2 reserves recorded.
- **A third club team will be permitted at the Organiser's discretion. This decision will be based on enough people being available to be judges & actors.

POOL ENTRY

All spectators and competitors are required to pay an entry fee daily.

Officials: Free entry for nominated officials.

Officials MUST sign the attendance sheet located at the front desk

ORGANISATION

Please note the following expectations and arrangements.

- 1 As part of the State Championship Program all SERC events carry point's allocation towards overall State Championship Pointscores.
- 2 Competitors (or a club representative) are required to act as patients or officials when not competing.
- 3 Club representatives on arrival should indicate the names of patients' availability.
- 4 A sign on sheet will be available in the clubhouse, ALL people attending MUST sign.

REQUIREMENTS

A Please note each club's requirements to enter the State Championships.

- 1 Clubs are required to provide members to act as patients or officials when not competing.
- 2 Each club is required to act as SERC- Test Organiser (STO) for at least one SERC event.
- 3 Clubs are expected to TOTALLY prepare their allocated event.
- 4 The requirements of TOTAL organisation are:-
 - Design the test and judges' sheets (use National protocol for the mark point's allocation).
 - Ensure that paperwork includes a separate equipment list and a patient list
 - Photocopy enough tests, judges' sheets, spectator sheets and associated paperwork. (or liaise with NSW Branch office for alternative copying) NB Judges sheets should be grouped for each judge, that is 12 copies of Judge 1 sheet together in own envelope. This is because the envelope is then given to the judge.
 - Ensure that one person member able to act as STO and another to act as equipment/patient organiser for the event. If competing in the prior event inform marshalling. So an early draw can be arranged.

B Test Requirements:-

- At least 3 judges for Individual tests and 4 judges for 4 team events.
- Ensure one judge's sheet has an allocation for overall points.
- Individual tests and U/16 pairs – 90 seconds
- 4 person teams – 90 seconds
- Individual tests have half of the area (25m x 4 lanes) with entry from the long side of the pool with patients able to be landed on the entry side and the edge at the shallow end of the pool. No landings allowed on the lane ropes or the starting block edge.
Open tests may have restricted entry and landing access areas dependant on written Test.
Open Individual tests will be the tank in the deep end of the pool and the U/16 the shallow end.
- U/16 Pairs SERC have full area (50m x 4 lanes) with entry from the long side of the pool with patients able to be landed on the side but not on the ends of the pool or the lane ropes.
- Team SERC have the full area (50m x 4 lanes) with entry and landing from only the long side of the pool. May have restricted entry and landing access areas dependant on written Test.

C Equipment available – ropes, rescue tubes, poles, first aid kits, spinal board, blow up toys, kickboards, 2 rescue manikins, water polo balls.

D Clubs to bring any unusual equipment not supplied by C&C equipment box located at ASTA. (see equipment list above)
